

TRADE AND TRAVEL FACTS—GERMANY

TRADE

- Germany is the largest European trading partner with the United States, and the 6th largest US export partner.
 - The US exports approximately \$53 billion in goods to Germany each year.¹ The top 3 exports are cars, civilian aircraft and aircraft parts, and pharmaceutical preparations.¹
 - Germany exports approximately \$118 billion in goods to the US each year.¹ The top exports include cars, car parts, and high-end medical equipment and machinery.¹

TRAVEL

- Approximately 2 million people travel from Germany to the US each year.¹
- More than 2.5 million people arrive in Germany from the US annually.³

ECONOMY AND POLITICS

- Germany is the strongest economy in the EU and is also a world economic leader. Germany's share of world exports is around 10%, which is higher than the US and just behind China.²
- Germany is the largest consumer market in the EU.¹
